Dear junior golfers and family,

Here at the golf academy we are looking forward to the various upcoming summer junior golf programs. Although Boone Creek Golf Club is under new ownership the staff here at the academy, Jim Buenzli, Mike Haase, and Kurt Sroka remains the same. In the clubhouse, Dave Mikolaitis (Mr. Dave), who has been teaching junior golf with us for the last 7 years, is the new general manager. You can now expect to receive the same level of customer service in the clubhouse that you've received here at the academy.

There will now be a section in the clubhouse pro shop dedicated specifically to junior golfers, including apparel, shoes, balls, gloves, hats and clubs sold individually or in a complete set. On Saturday, June 6th, any junior that is signed up for one of our programs may play 9 holes for free after 4pm when accompanied by a paid adult. Also, that evening you will receive a 20% discount on any junior golf apparel or equipment.

Our classes for the younger player, ages 5-7, are all about having fun at the golf course and learning some basic fundamentals along the way. These classes meet once a week for 4 weeks and includes 90 minutes of instruction. There is a 4 hole tournament at the conclusion of the program where parents are encouraged to caddie and spectate.

The programs for golfers ages 8-14 all consist of instruction covering the basic fundamentals of the game, including full swing, putting, chipping, sand shots, the rules of golf, and course etiquette. These classes meet once each week for four weeks and include two hours of instruction followed by nine holes of golf with approximately a 6 to 1 student to teacher ratio. These Level I classes have a tournament at the conclusion of the season.

We also offer Level II classes for the more experienced player. This class is for the golfer who we feel is ready for tournament play. A more in depth look at the golf swing, practice strategies, the mental side of golf, and tournament preparation are all covered in this program. The Level II programs meet nine times total. Six dates consist of instruction followed by nine holes of golf. The other three dates are tournaments for the Level II students and are designed to prepare players for the experience and challenges of tournament golf. This is a great program for the player looking to play competitive golf in high school. There is a 6 to 1 student to teacher ratio in the Level II classes.

We suggest private lessons as the next step in the process for the child who has shown a proficiency in tournament play. For information on local tournaments please contact us here at the academy.

As we have in the past, we will continue to provide on course supervision and instruction when the kids go out to play. There will be two to three instructors (depending on class size) with each class on the course teaching etiquette, course strategy, and safety. This not only provides a safer environment for our junior golfers, but it also helps them learn to shoot lower scores and become better players that much faster.

On the following pages you will find both Level I and Level II class schedules, with the Level I classes separated into two sessions. Both Level I sessions have the same curriculum.
