Dear junior golfers and family,

Here at the golf academy our goals concerning junior golf are:

1. To develop athletic abilities
2. Teach golf & life skills that will enhance enjoyment playing the game
3. To develop a love and passion for the game.

Our Level I classes for the younger player, ages 5-7, are all about having fun at the golf course and learning some basic athletic skills. These classes meet once a week for 4 weeks and includes 90 minutes of activities. There is a 4 hole tournament at the conclusion of the program where parents are encouraged to caddie and spectate.

Level I programs for golfers ages 8-14 all consist of instruction covering the basic fundamentals of the game, including full swing, putting, chipping, sand shots, the rules of golf, and course etiquette. These classes meet once each week for four weeks and include two hours of instruction followed by nine holes of golf (6 holes for 8-9 year old boys and 8-14 year old girls) with approximately a 6 to 1 student to teacher ratio. These Level I classes have a tournament at the conclusion of the season.

Level II classes are for the junior golfer who we feel is ready to begin competitive play. Basic fundamentals, simple mechanics, shotmaking, mental toughness, course management, rules and etiquette will all be covered. The Level II programs meet nine times total. Six dates consist of instruction followed by nine holes of golf. The other three dates are tournaments for the Level II students and are designed to prepare players for the experience and challenges of tournament golf. This is a great program for the player looking to play competitive golf in high school. There is a 6 to 1 student to teacher ratio in the Level II classes.

As we have in the past, we will continue to provide on course supervision and instruction when the kids go out to play. There will be two to three instructors (depending on class size) with each class on the course teaching etiquette, course strategy, and safety. This not only provides a safer environment for our junior golfers, but it also helps them learn to shoot lower scores and become better players that much faster. We will continue to provide family tee markers on our 9-hole course and a specifically designed junior scorecard.

We suggest private lessons as the next step in the process for the child who has shown a proficiency in tournament play.
